

Terms of reference

Environment & Highways Committee

The committee shall be quorate with three members attending.

The committee has overall policy responsibility for all issues regarding highways matters that affect Drayton. This includes major arterial roads outside of the parish that feed into and affect Drayton.

The Committee has delegated authority over all street scene issues including bus shelters, grit & litter bins, noticeboards, grass verges and seats/benches.

The committee is responsible for the consideration and maintenance for the area off Low Road known as Green Lanes.

When changes are proposed for the highway, transport network or public transport services in Drayton, the Committee should consider these and make recommendations for the Council to consider as necessary.

The committee is responsible for ensuring a comprehensive tree management policy is in place and actions arising from that policy are implemented in a timely fashion.

The committee is responsible for the implementation and promotion of recycling initiatives within the council and the parish.

The committee is responsible for arranging a Drayton resident's garden competition.

The committee will recommend to the Council any actions it feels necessary to protect the general environment and amenities of the village.
